Stewards spoke to kennel representative Mr Frank Italia regarding the greyhound pulling up prior to the return gate and failing to enter the catching pen. After hearing evidence from Mr Italia, viewing the available race footage and acting on their observations, a warning was issued.

Trendy Miss underwent a post-race veterinary examination at the request of the trainer and was found to have a laceration under the left eye. A7 day stand down period was imposed.

In accordance with GAR 156(w) Miss Callie Wilson was issued with a warning regarding the noncompliance with the GRV Dress Code.

Mazikeen Smith was slow to begin. The announcement of the All Clear was delayed for the Stewards to review the race footage after it was noted that a bandage had been dislodged from a greyhound during the running of the event. After viewing the footage and acting on their own observations, the Stewards were comfortably satisfied that no greyhounds were materially affected, so as to effect the outcome of the event. The All Clear was posted. Mazikeen Smith marred in the home straight, underwent a post–race veterinary examination – no apparent injury was reported. Stewards spoke to kennel representative Mr Dermott Prout regarding the greyhound's racing manners in the home straight. Acting under the provisions of GAR 123 Mazikeen Smith was charged with marring. Mr Prout pled guilty to the charge, Mazikeen Smith was found guilty and suspended for 28 days at Sandown and must perform a Satisfactory Trial in accordance with GAR 127, and pursuant to GAR 132, before any future nomination will be accepted.
