A five day stand down period was imposed. Stewards spoke to Mr Trevor Steel, the trainer of Chasing Jimmy regarding the greyhound's racing manners in the home straight. Acting under the provisions of GAR 124 Chasing Jimmy was charged with failing to pursue the lure with due commitment. Mr Steel pleaded guilty to the charge.
