A 60 day stand down period was imposed.</p> <p>Ring A Dusty was severely checked on the first turn, underwent a post-race veterinary examination and was found to have injuries to the left monkey and left wrist. Mrs Chignell pled guilty to the charge, Alvin Rose was found guilty and suspended for 28 days at Warragul and must perform a Satisfactory Trial in accordance with GAR 127, and pursuant to GAR 132, before any future nomination will be accepted.</p> <p>Renegade Ruslie visibly eased in the home straight, underwent a post-race veterinary examination and was found to have a left shoulder injury. A 3 day stand down period was imposed. Stewards spoke to Russell Edwards regarding Renegade Ruslie's racing manners in the home straight. Acting under the provisions of GAR 124 Renegade Ruslie was charged with failing to pursue the lure with due commitment. Mr Edwards pled not guilty to the charge, Renegade Ruslie was found guilty and suspended for 28 days at Warragul and must perform a Satisfactory Trial in accordance with GAR 127, and pursuant to GAR 132, before any future nomination will be accepted.</p> <p>Mai Spolly underwent a post-race veterinary examination at the request of the trainer and was found to have injuries to the right triangle and right quadriceps.
