Solar Toby was slow to begin.</p> <p>Grumbler raced wide on the home turn and collided with Aston Capon, underwent a post-race veterinary examination – no apparent injury was reported.</p> <p>Stewards spoke to Mr Cameron Taylor regarding the racing manners of Grumbler on the home turn. After hearing submissions from Mr. Cameron Taylor, viewing the available race footage and having their own observations, Stewards took no further action.</p>

<p style="text-align: center;">Race 2</p> <p>CHS GROUP FINAL 3:39 pm 485m Maiden</p>	<p>A pre-race sample was taken from Stormin' Frank.</p> <p>Stormin' Frank was slow to begin.</p> <p>This event was hand timed-27.606.</p> <p>A post-race sample was taken from Quest For Extra - the winner of the event.</p>

<p style="text-align: center;">Race 3</p> <p>HORSHAM DOORS & GLASS 3:57 pm 410m Grade 7</p>	<p>This event was delayed four (4) minutes due to the failure of the trip mechanism. As a result this event was manually started.</p> <p>Stewards held the All Clear after there was a significant delay to the boxes opening, and they then opened when the lure was well beyond the correct starting point as prescribed in GAR 108 (3). This also caused the lure to be initially positioned well beyond the required distance of between 5-8 metres as GAR 109 prescribes. After reviewing all available video footage and acting on their observations, the Stewards were not comfortably satisfied that the incident had no effect on the outcome of the race. Therefore, pursuant to GAR 110 the event was declared a 'No Race'. All bets are refunded. The weights recorded for the greyhounds are void and do not count for the purposes of the weight rule at the greyhounds' next start. The event was then abandoned, with prizemoney to be split evenly between the greyhounds which competed.</p>
