# Race 1

After hearing submissions from Ms. Morris, viewing the available race footage, and acting on their observations, Stewards deemed the performance of Zealous Alex unsatisfactory. Zealous Alex must perform a Satisfactory Trial in accordance with GAR 129, and pursuant to GAR 132, before any future nomination will be accepted.
