A 14 day stand down period was imposed.</p> <p>Dark Night collided with the running rail, underwent a post-race veterinary examination and was found to have no apparent injury.</p> <p>Parumba Special fell entering the first turn, underwent a post-race veterinary examination and was found to have no apparent injury.</p> <p>A post-race sample was taken from Akina Jack - winner of the event.</p>

A 14 day stand down period was imposed. Stewards spoke to trainer Ms. Gail Saunders about the greyhound's actions through the first turn. After considering Ms. Saunders' comments and the post-race veterinary examination, Stewards took no further action.</p> <p>Aragog collided with Rebel May Road on the first turn, was severely checked, underwent a post-race veterinary examination and was found to have an abraded paw pad on the left hind. No stand down period was imposed.</p> <p>Stewards spoke with Mr. Malcolm Carr, trainer of Majestic Jay, concerning his expectations of the greyhound's performance in the event. Mr. Carr advised Stewards that he was confident of a strong showing in the event given the favourable box draw and that he had supported the greyhound in the event.</p>

Acting under the provisions of GAR 125, Trenzalore was charged with failing to pursue the lure with due commitment (by reason of injury). Mr. Fisher pled guilty to the charge, Trenzalore must perform a Satisfactory Trial in accordance with GAR 125, and pursuant to GAR 132, before any future nomination will be accepted.</p>
