examination - no apparent injury was reported.

11:02 am 390m Tier 3 - Grade 7 Aston Erin was slow to begin.

A post-race sample was taken from Carleton Story - the winner of the event.

Mr. Keith Lloyd failed to appear at the kennels by the appointed time to retrieve and prepare Carleton Story

for racing. A warning was issued pursuant to GAR 97(2).

Tier 3 - Grade 7

Leggero was quick to begin. Buzz Out and Jacquinot Jet were slow to begin.

Leggero lost ground in the home straight, underwent a post-race veterinary examination and was found to have a right-fore carpal sprain. A 10 day stand down period was imposed. Stewards spoke to trainer Mr. Stephen Brincat who advised that Leggero may now be sent for an extended spell. Mr. Brincat believes a spell may have a positive impact on the greyhound's form going forward.

After hearing submissions from Mr. Bryce, viewing the available race footage and having their own observations, the Stewards issued a warning to connections regarding the greyhound's racing manners in the home straight.

Fernando Bubbles failed to enter the catching pen and underwent a post-race veterinary examination - no apparent injury was reported. After considering the circumstances and hearing from kennel representative Mr. Jason Portelli, Stewards advised they would take no further action on this occasion, though will monitor the greyhound in future events.
