Stewards spoke to Mr Tracie Price, the trainer of Giant's Flash regarding the greyhound's racing manners on the home turn and approaching the winning post. Acting under the provisions of GAR 123 Giant's Flash was charged with marring. Mr Price pleaded guilty to the charge, Giant's Flash was found guilty and suspended for three months at all tracks and must perform two Satisfactory Trials in accordance with GAR 127, and pursuant to GAR 132, before any future nomination will be accepted.

A post-race sample was taken from Kippy Bale – the winner of the event.

Race 7 NORFOLK BUTCHERS 7:49 pm 390m Grade 4	<p>Curly Fries underwent a post–race veterinary examination and was found to have an abrasion to the right hindleg foot. No stand down period was imposed. Stewards spoke to trainer, Mr Peter Byrne regarding Curly Fries pulling up prior to the return gate and failing to enter the catching pen. Acting in accordance with GAR 129 and being mindful of the safety of Curly Fries, other greyhounds in the race and staff that triage these types of incidents, the Stewards were not satisfied with the performance and placed Curly Fries on a satisfactory trial under GAR 129, and in accordance with GAR 132, with the condition that Curly Fries needs to run past the return gate in order to pass the satisfactory trial.</p> <p>A post–race sample was taken from Run Machine – the winner of the event.</p>
