#### Race 1

BENDIGO ADVERTISER (250+ RANK)

9:25 am 425m Maiden Mia River and Max Inferno were slow to begin.

Mia River (severly checked approaching the second turn) underwent a post–race veterinary examination and was found to have a right wrist sprain. A 10 day stand down period was imposed.

Yeah The Boy (stumbled and lost ground approaching the first turn) underwent a post–race veterinary examination and was found to have a right spike wound. No stand down period was imposed.

Diablo Bale (visibly eased and marred the running of Swanny River in the home straight) underwent a post–race veterinary examination and was found to have a right triangle and left wrist injury. A 14 day stand down period was imposed.

Stewards spoke to Trainer Mr J.Caulfield regarding Diablo Bale's racing manners in the home straight. Acting under the provisions of GAR 123 Diablo Bale was charged with marring. Mr Caulfield pleaded guilty to the charge, Diablo Bale was found guilty and suspended for 28 days at Bendigo and must perform a Satisfactory Trial/s in accordance with GAR 127, and pursuant to GAR 132, before any future nomination will be accepted.

Swanny River - Proved difficult to box and will be boxed first in future events in accordance with GAR 106.

A post-race sample was taken from Diablo Bale - the winner of the event.

### Race 2

SPORTSBET BS RESPONSIBLY (250+

RANK) 9:42 am 425m Grade 7 Sir Nathan and Coalville Girl were slow to begin

A post-race sample was taken from Little Edward - the winner of the event.

SPORTSBET GREEN TICKS (250+

RANK) 9:57 am 425m Grade 6 Lektra Dish was quick to begin. Louisiana Reef was slow to begin.

Jocularity (lost ground approaching the home turn) underwent a post–race veterinary examination – no apparent injury was reported.

Lektra Dish (severely checked approaching the home turn) underwent a post–race veterinary examination and was found to have split webbing to the right hind toes. A 14 day stand down period was imposed.

A post-race sample was taken from Prince Pulpogan - the winner of the event.

RANK) 10:15 am 500m Mixed 6/7 Aquata – Late scratching at 8:58am after a confirmed telephone call from Trainer Mr S.Millard reported that the greyhound to have vomiting (GAR 76). A 10 day stand down period was imposed. Stewards will require a veterinary certificate pursuant to GAR 19(3)(w) before any future nominations will be accepted.

Disorder was slow to begin.

Rock Icon (frequency of racing) underwent a post–race veterinary examination and was found to have a carpal wrist injury. A 10 day stand down period was imposed.

A post-race sample was taken from Boot A Dream - the winner of the event.

AG TYRES & WHEELS (250+ RANK) 10:32 am Pursuant to GAR 75(6) Starter, Mr J.Holt did not act in any official capacity that may have in any way, affected the outcome of this event.

Celtic Bouy was slow to begin.

425m Grade 5 Starchie (lost ground approaching the home turn) underwent a post–race veterinary examination – no apparent injury was reported.

Stewards spoke to Trainer Mr B.Merton regarding the racing manners of Starchie. After hearing submissions from Mr Merton, viewing the available race footage and having their own observations, Stewards took no further action.

A post-race sample was taken from Rogan Bale - the winner of the event.

GREYHOUND CLUBS VICTORIA (250+

RANK) 10:50 am 500m Grade 5 Mcivor Clyde was quick to begin. Wichita Bale was slow to begin.

Tiggerlong Rebel underwent a post–race veterinary examination at the trainer's request and was found to have a right wrist injury. A 21 day stand down period was imposed.

A post-race sample was taken from Bruce's Ruslie - the winner of the event.

#### Race 7

HANRAHAN PLUMBING (250+ RANK)

11:07 am 425m Mixed 4/5 Junior Marjen – Late scratching at 8:34am due to weight variation (GAR 101). A 10 day stand down period was imposed. Trainer, Mr C.Knott was fined \$100.

Very Unstable was very slow to begin (6 lengths).

Very Unstable (slow to begin and uncompetitive) underwent a post–race veterinary examination – no apparent injury was reported.

Stewards spoke to Trainer Mr D.Petersen regarding Very Unstables's performance and racing manners in the event. After hearing submissions from Mr Petersen, viewing the available race footage and acting on their observations, Stewards deemed the performance of Very Unstable unsatisfactory. Very Unstable must perform a Satisfactory Trial in accordance with GAR 129, and pursuant to GAR 132, before any future nomination will be accepted.

A post-race sample was taken from Mad Brax - the winner of the event.
