<b>Race 1</b> THE BECKLEY CENTRE GEELONG 2:49 pm 400m Maiden	<p>South West Smith, Daisy Gible and Sky High Riot were slow to begin.</p> <p>South West Smith contacted the running rail on the first turn and underwent a post-race veterinary examination – no apparent injury was reported.</p>
<b>Race 2</b> SPORTSBET WE LET THE DOGS OUT 3:09 pm 460m Maiden	<p>Ubiquitousness and Ludo Bagman were quick to begin.</p> <p>Tanamera (failed to pursue the lure in the home straight), underwent a post-race veterinary examination and was found to have a spike wound to the right hind foot. A 3 day stand down period was imposed. Stewards spoke to Trainer Ms A. Langton regarding the greyhound's racing manners in the home straight. Acting under the provisions of GAR 125, Tanamera was charged with failing to pursue the lure with due commitment (by reason of injury). Ms Langton pled guilty to the charge, Panamera must perform a satisfactory trial in accordance with GAR 125, and pursuant to GAR 132, before any future nomination will be accepted.</p> <p>A post-race sample was taken from Ludo Bagman – the winner of the event.</p>

<b>Race 9</b> GEELONG PRINTING 5:49 pm 460m Mixed 6/7	<p>An out of competition sample was taken from Daytona on 17/10/2022 pursuant to GAR 139.</p> <p>A pre–race sample was taken from Holly's Entity.</p> <p>Aussie Showgirl was quick to begin. Dig Dag was slow to begin.</p> <p>Holly's Entity [handler's request], underwent a post–race veterinary examination and was found to have a laceration to the left fore. A 14 day stand down period was imposed.</p>
<b>Race 10</b> GREYHOUND CLUBS VICTORIA 6:05 pm 400m Mixed 6/7	<p>Hello Jett was slow to begin.</p> <p>Summer Riot turned it's head outwards on the first turn, underwent a post–race veterinary examination and was re-examined following race 12 - no apparent injury was reported. Stewards spoke to trainer Mr. Colin Bermingham regarding Summer Riot's racing manners on the first turn. Acting under the provisions of GAR 124 Summer Riot was charged with failing to pursue the lure with due commitment. Mr. Bermingham pled guilty to the charge, Summre Riot was found guilty and suspended for 28 days at Geelong only and must perform a satisfactory trial in accordance with GAR 127, and pursuant to GAR 132, before any future nomination will be accepted.</p> <p>Tinker Clark failed to pursue in the back straight, underwent a post–race veterinary examination - no apparent injury was reported. Stewards spoke to trainer Ms. Michelle Mallia regarding Tinker Clark's racing manners in the back straight. Acting under the provisions of GAR 124 Tinker Clark was charged with failing to pursue the lure with due commitment. Ms Mallia pled guilty to the charge, Tinker Clark was found guilty and suspended for 28 days at Geelong only and must perform a satisfactory trial in accordance with GAR 127, and pursuant to GAR 132, before any future nomination will be accepted.</p> <p>A post–race sample was taken from Hello Jett – the winner of the event.</p> <p>Trainer Ms C. Allen pleaded guilty to a charge of negligence pursuant to GAR 156(f). The particulars of the charge being that Ms Allen negligently retrieved the incorrect greyhound from the kennels and commenced to transport the greyhound. After considering the matter Ms Allen was fined \$100.</p>
