Race 1 MACEY'S BISTRO 5:34 pm 450m Maiden	Send It Blue was slow to begin. Post-race samples were taken from Hey Tootle (1st) and Aston Skipper (3rd).
Race 2 FIND US ON FACEBOOK 5:54 pm 390m Maiden	Sassy Skye and Tamarind Twist were slow to begin.
Race 3 NORFOLK BUTCHERS 6:12 pm 390m Maiden	There were no reportable incidents in the event.
Race 4 WARRNAMBOOL FENCING SPECIALISTS 6:34 pm 390m Mixed 6/7	A pre-race sample was taken from Betty's Baklava. Mepunga Tilly eased approaching the winning post, underwent a post-race veterinary examination – no apparent injury was reported. Stewards spoke to Mr Harrison Goss, the representative of Mepunga Tilly regarding the greyhound's racing manners approaching the winning post. Acting under the provisions of GAR 124 Mepunga Tilly was charged with failing to pursue the lure with due commitment. Mr Goss pleaded guilty to the charge, Mepunga Tilly was found guilty and suspended for 28 days at Warrnambool and must perform a Satisfactory Trial in accordance with GAR 127, and pursuant to GAR 132, before any future nomination will be accepted. Kalyara severely checked on the first turn, underwent a post-race veterinary examination – no apparent injury was reported.
Race 5 GREYHOUND ADOPTION PROGRAM 6:52 pm 390m Grade 5	Javen Bale – New declared weight of 31.9 kg, last raced at 33.3 kg. Pai Gow Poker was slow to begin. Pai Gow Poker severely checked on the first turn, underwent a post-race veterinary examination and was found to have spike wounds to the left hock and right hindleg webbing. No stand down period was imposed.
Race 6 CASSIGN DESIGN DAMSELS DASH 7:13 pm 390m Grade 5	An out of competition sample was taken from Palmer River on Tuesday, 11 October 2022 pursuant to GAR 139. A pre-race sample was taken from Lamonica. A post-race sample was taken from Pressure Rising – the winner of the event.

Race 7 EDWARDS ELECTRICAL 7:31 pm 390m Grade 5	<p>Chilly Bin and Bourne Blue were slow to begin.</p> <p>Doonside Hub passing the first turn veered out and marred Blaze Of Fire, and in the home straight turned its head inwards and collided with Joffa's Liberty, underwent a post-race veterinary examination and was found to have a right foreleg wrist abrasion. No stand down period was imposed. Stewards spoke to Mr Darren Fisher, the trainer of Doonside Hub regarding the greyhound's racing manners passing the first turn and in the home straight. Acting under the provisions of GAR 123 Doonside Hub was charged with marring. Mr Fisher pleaded guilty to the charge, Doonside Hub was found guilty and suspended for 28 days at Warrnambool and must perform a Satisfactory Trial in accordance with GAR 127, and pursuant to GAR 132, before any future nomination will be accepted.</p>
