<b>Race 2</b> HORSHAM DOORS & GLASS 3:24 pm 410m Maiden	Solar Revel was quick to begin. Deep Purple was slow to begin.
<b>Race 3</b> CHS GROUP 3:44 pm 485m Maiden	<p>Miss Giveaway underwent a veterinary examination prior to racing and was passed fit to race.</p> <p>Miss Giveaway was slow to begin.</p> <p>Stewards viewed the head-on vision in the back straight and noted a plover chick in the centre of the track, the field raced over and past the chick without incident.</p> <p>Miss Giveaway which trailed the field throughout, underwent a post-race veterinary examination and was found to have a slow recovery and likely developing an unknown illness. A 10 day stand down period was imposed.</p>

Solar Rock, Master Spencer and Crymelon Libby were slow to begin.</p> <p>Stewards spoke to trainer, Ms Briana Robertson-Leech regarding the racing manners of Orford Bale approaching the winning post. After hearing submissions from Ms Robertson-Leech, viewing the available race footage and having their own observations, Stewards took no further action.</p>
