Acting in accordance with GAR 129 and being mindful of the safety of Winnindoo Wendy, other greyhounds in the race and staff that triage these types of incidents, the Stewards were not satisfied with the performance and placed Winnindoo Wendy on a satisfactory trial under GAR 129, and in accordance with GAR 132, with the condition that Winnindoo Wendy needs to remain in the catching pen in order to pass the trial.
