Holy Smoke (fell on the first turn), underwent a post–race veterinary examination and was found to have a right calf injury. A 5 day stand down period was imposed.

Zipping Dixie (marred Noah Charles on the first turn). Stewards spoke to Kennel Representative Mr. Luke Adams regarding Zipping Dixie's racing manners. Acting under the provisions of GAR 123, Zipping Dixie was charged with marring. Mr. Adams pleaded guilty to the charge, Zipping Dixie was suspended for 28 days at all tracks and must perform a satisfactory trial in accordance with GAR 127, and pursuant to GAR 132, before any future nomination will be accepted.

Counterpunch (marred Krystal Bale on the home turn), underwent a post–race veterinary examination and was found to have an injury to the right stopper, left monkey muscle and a spike wound to the left-hind calf. A 10 day stand down period was imposed. Stewards spoke to Trainer Ms Lyn Smith regarding the greyhound's racing manners on the home turn. Acting under the provisions of GAR 123, Counterpunch was charged with marring. Ms Smith pleaded guilty to the charge, Counterpunch was suspended for 28 days at Sandown only and must perform a satisfactory trial in accordance with GAR 127, and pursuant to GAR 132, before any future nomination will be accepted.

Cardigan Girl (fell on the first turn), underwent a post–race veterinary examination and was found to have a fracture to the right hind tibia and fibula. A 90 day stand down period was imposed.

Noah Charles (marred by Zipping Dixie), underwent a post–race veterinary examination and was found to have a right monkey injury. A 5 day stand down period was imposed.

Krystal Bale (marred by Counterpunch), underwent a post-race veterinary examination and was found to

have shin soreness to the left fore, a left wrist sprain and a left monkey injury. A 14 day stand down period was imposed.

Winnindoo Wendy (escaped the catching pen) underwent a post-race veterinary examination and was found to have abrasions to the left metacarpals and metatarsals. No stand down period applied. Stewards spoke to trainer Mr. Donald Rhodes regarding the greyhound escaping the catching pen. After hearing submissions from Mr Rhodes and acting on their observations, Stewards deemed Winnindoo Wendy escaping the catching pen unsatisfactory. Winnindoo Wendy must perform a satisfactory trial in accordance with GAR 129, and pursuant to GAR 132, before any future nomination will be accepted.
