<b>Race 1</b> SPORTSBET MAKE IT LOOK EASY 3:02 pm 425m Mixed 6/7	Bok Choy was quick to begin. Cindy's Kyle was slow to begin.
<b>Race 2</b> BENDIGO ADVERTISER GDR (0-4 WINS) 3:27 pm 660m Restricted Win	Magic Destroyer and Rumour Has It were slow to begin. A post-race sample was taken from Rumour Has It – the winner of the event.
<b>Race 3</b> HIP POCKET BENDIGO GDR (0-4 WINS) 3:50 pm 660m Restricted Win	A post-race sample was taken from Riptide Ruslie – the winner of the event.
<b>Race 4</b> MANNINGS GREYHOUND COMPLEX 4:07 pm 425m Grade 5	An out of competition sample was taken from Spring Gonzales on 28 February 2023 pursuant to GAR 139. Spring Gonzales was slow to begin. Hail Zeus was very slow to begin (5 lengths). Red's Shout (severely checked and fell on the first turn), underwent a post-race veterinary examination and was found to have a fractured right fore leg. A 90 day stand down period was imposed. Prince Of Melton (severely checked and fell on the first turn), underwent a post-race veterinary examination and was found to have a left back muscle, right quadricep injury and a chest injury. A 14 day stand down period was imposed. Queen of Stripes (checked on the first turn and lost ground approaching the home turn) underwent a post-race veterinary examination and was found to have a right back muscle injury. A 60 day stand down period was imposed. Following the running of this event, Stewards inspected the track on the first turn to the home turn and deemed it satisfactory for racing.

A 5 day stand down period was imposed.</p> <p>Uncle Rosco underwent a post–race veterinary examination at the trainer's request and was found to have tail injury. A 5 day stand down period was imposed.</p> <p>Break Ranks underwent a post–race veterinary examination and was found to have a pencil and quadricep injury. A 10 day stand down period was imposed.</p> <p>Stewards spoke to Mr. Gary Webb regarding Break Ranks' racing manners in the home straight. Acting under the provisions of GAR 125, Break Ranks was charged with failing to pursue the lure with due commitment (by reason of injury). Gary Webb pled guilty to the charge, Break Ranks was found guilty and must perform a Satisfactory Trial in accordance with GAR 125, and pursuant to GAR 132, before any future nomination will be accepted.</p> <p>A post–race sample was taken from Jack Hook – the winner of the event.</p>
