Stewards spoke to trainer, Mr Garry Selkrig regarding Kanji War's racing manners in the back straight. Acting under the provisions of GAR 123 Kanji War was charged with marring. Mr Selkrig pled not guilty to the charge, Kanji War was found guilty and suspended for 28 days at Bendigo and must perform a Satisfactory Trial in accordance with GAR 127, and pursuant to GAR 132, before any future nomination will be accepted.
