Race 1

3:22 pm 400m Tier 3 - Maiden Copper Blonde was quick to begin.

Copper Blonde was severely checked and stumbled approaching the winning post, underwent a post–race veterinary examination and was found to have a left triangle muscle injury. A 5 day stand down period was imposed.

A pre-race sample was taken from Talent Show.

Prince Of Egypt, Magnetic Man and Tommy Tornado were slow to begin.

Tommy Tornado underwent a post–race veterinary examination and was found to have a left hamstring injury. A 5 day stand down period was imposed. Stewards spoke to Mr. Gary Joske regarding the racing manners of Tommy Tornado in the home straight. After hearing submissions from Mr. Joske, viewing the available race footage and having their own observations, the Stewards issued a warning to connections regarding the greyhound's racing manners in the home straight.

460m Tier 3 - Restricted Win A pre-race sample was taken from Voice Of Thunder.

Aquata was quick to begin. Cindarella Story and Soul's Warning were slow to begin.

Race 5

BLUE STREAM PICTURES

4:24 pm 400m Grade 5 T3 Enraged – Late scratching at 12.55pm by Order of Stewards in the best interests of greyhound racing, in accordance with GAR 19(4)(b).

Mr. Andrew Wood failed to appear at the kennels by the appointed time to retrieve and prepare Dundee Silk for racing. A warning was issued pursuant to GAR 97(2).

Love A Collision was slow to begin.

Dundee Silk visibly eased in the home straight, underwent a post-race veterinary examination and was re–examined following race 7 - no apparent injury was reported. Stewards spoke to Mr. Corry Kas regarding Dundee Silk's racing manners on the home turn. Acting under the provisions of GAR 124, Dundee Silk was charged with failing to pursue the lure with due commitment. Mr. Kas pled guilty to the charge, Dundee Silk was found guilty and suspended for 28 days at Warragul and must perform a Satisfactory Trial in accordance with GAR 127, and pursuant to GAR 132, before any future nomination will be accepted.

There was no head-on vision available in the back straight for this event.

Panza Attack was checked turning off the back straight, lost ground, underwent a post-race veterinary examination and was found to have a right triangle muscle injury and a spike wound on the left calf. A 7 day stand down period was imposed.

Banjo Jack was slow to begin.
