No stand down period was imposed.</p> <p>Silver Blade was severley checked on the first turn, underwent a post-race veterinary examination and was found to have an abrasion on the left front metacarpal. No stand down period was imposed.</p> <p>A post-race blood sample was taken from Not For Profit - the winner of the event in a new track record time of 19.31.</p>
<b>Race 8</b> SURFACE CO 9:11 pm 450m Mixed 4/5	<p>Audacious Stell was slow to begin.</p> <p>A post-race sample was taken from Awesome Swan - the winner of the event.</p>
<b>Race 9</b> ZACK MONELLI @ STUD (2-3 WINS) 9:27 pm 395m Restricted Win	<p>Dan Dan and Elenor Bale were quick to begin.</p> <p>Elenor Bale turned its head on the home turn, underwent a post-race veterinary examination and was found to have an abrasion on the left hind metatarsal. A 5 day stand down period was imposed. Stewards spoke to Mrs Tammy Kennedy-Harris regarding the greyhound's racing manners on the home turn. Acting under the provisions of GAR 125, Elenor Bale was charged with failing to pursue the lure with due commitment (by reason of injury).
