12:55 pm 425m Maiden Heat The start was delayed by approximately two minutes due to holding for a New Zealand thoroughbred event.

Tell Me Again was quick to begin. Rock The Cash was slow to begin.

Smooth Avenger (turned its head inwards in the home straight) underwent a post–race veterinary examination and was re–examined following race 10. Smooth Avenger was found to have a right pencil muscle injury. A 7 day stand down period was imposed.

Stewards spoke to Trainer Mr J.Borg regarding Smooth Avenger's racing manners in the home straight. Acting under the provisions of GAR 125, Smooth Avenger was charged with failing to pursue the lure with due commitment (by reason of injury). Mr Borg pleaded guilty to the charge, Smooth Avenger was found guilty and must perform a Satisfactory Trial in accordance with GAR 125, and pursuant to GAR 132, before any future nomination will be accepted.

Post-race urine and hair samples were taken from Aston Radar (1st) and Tell Me Again (2nd).
