Race 1

Stewards spoke to trainer, Ms Rebekah Dudley regarding the racing manners of Silly Sally on the home turn. After hearing submissions from Ms Dudley, viewing the available race footage and having their own observations, Stewards took no further action.

Following the event Nourish displayed mild signs of Post Exercise Distress Syndrome (PEDS). As a result, the greyhound underwent a post-race veterinary examination and was found to be displaying clinical signs of Ataxia/Hypermetria. A 7 day stand down penalty was imposed.

Stewards spoke to Mr Brent Merton, the trainer of Nourish and advised him that the greyhound would be closely monitored in future starts.

A post-race sample was taken from Abysmal - the winner of the event.
