Race 1

THE BECKLEY CENTRE GEELONG

(300+RANK) 2:37 pm 400m Maiden Sagan Bale was quick to begin. Cawbourne Echo was slow to begin.

Cawbourne Echo faltered turning out of the back straight and subsequently tailed off, underwent a post-race veterinary examination and was re–examined following race 4. Cawbourne Echo was found to have a left carpal sprain. A 10 day stand down period was imposed.

A post-race sample was taken from Sagan Bale - the winner of the event.

Race 2

SPORTSBET BET WITH MATES (300+RANK)

2:52 pm 400m Maiden An out of competition sample was taken from Quest For Luck on 22 December 2022 pursuant to GAR 139.

Perfect Stranger was slow to begin

Laid Back was severely checked by Go Gizmo Go entering the home straight and underwent a post–race veterinary examination – no apparent injury was reported.

Quest For Luck underwent a post–race veterinary examination and was found to have a left carpal sprain. A 7 day stand down period was imposed. Stewards spoke to trainer Mr. Leslie Kenyon regarding Quest For Luck's racing manners approaching the winning post. Acting under the provisions of GAR 125, Quest For Luck was charged with failing to pursue the lure with due commitment (by reason of injury). Mr. Kenyon pled guilty to the charge, Quest For Luck was found guilty and must perform a Satisfactory Trial in accordance with GAR 125, and pursuant to GAR 132, before any future nomination will be accepted.

A post-race sample was taken from Quest For Luck - the winner of the event.

Race 3

MERV JENNINGS SIGNS (300+RANK)

3:14 pm 460m Maiden Stewards interviewed Mr. Craig Treherne in relation to the bona fides of the withdrawal of Bar Banter from this race. Stewards noted the comments.

Good Manner was a late scratching at 14:15 by Order of Stewards after it was established that the incorrect greyhound had been presented. At a subsequent inquiry, Stewards issued a charge under GAR 86 to Mr. Neil Jones for failing to present the correct greyhound to the Stewards for this event. Mr Jones pleaded guilty to the charge and was fined \$250. The 28 day stand down period imposed on Good Manner was revoked.

Late For Love and Pick A Posy were slow to begin.

A post–race sample was taken from Pick A Posy – the winner of the event.
