Race 1 THE BECKLEY CENTRE GEELONG 7:19 pm 400m Maiden	Lampent Bale underwent a post-race veterinary examination, the greyhound was unable to be thoroughly examined due to its behaviour. No injury was detected. Stewards spoke to representative Ms D. Coleman regarding the racing manners of Lampent Bale soon after the start. After hearing submissions from Ms D. Coleman, viewing the available race footage and having their own observations, the Stewards issued a warning to connections. Ms Coleman was also advised that if the greyhound's behaviour continues to prevent a thorough veterinary examination being undertaken action may be taken against the greyhound pursuant to GAR 131.
	Tinker Chris underwent a post-race veterinary examination – no apparent injury was reported. Stewards spoke to representative Mr C. Burns regarding the racing manners of Tinker Chris turning off the back straight. After hearing submissions from Mr C. Burns, viewing the available race footage and acting on their own observations, the Stewards took no action. In arriving at this decision, Stewards were mindful of Tinker Chris and Veluza Bale racing tightly, Lampent Bale then shifts down the track in front of those greyhounds, soon after Solo Traveller and Tinker Chris race tightly then both greyhounds become significantly off-balance and lose ground at that part of the race. A post-race sample was taken from Lyrical Lassy – the winner of the event.
