Victini Bale hit the inside running rail, checked and fell on the first turn, underwent a post-race veterinary examination and was found to have a fractured right wrist. Victini Bale was humanely euthanised.

Manson faltered on the home turn, underwent a post-race veterinary examination and was found to have a fractured right hock. Manson was humanely euthanised.

A post-race sample was taken from Zipping Faye - the winner of the event.

Following the running of this event, Stewards inspected the track and had some concerns with it's suitability for racing. As such, racing was indefinitely delayed at approximately 5.20pm to afford track staff the opportunity to remediate the observed concerns. The track was unable to be remediated. Due to the unsuitable track surface, the race meeting was abandoned at 6.09pm, pursuant to GAR 110 (4). All bets on greyhounds in the abandoned races are to be refunded. The weights recorded for the greyhounds in the abandoned races are void and do not count for the purposes of the weight rule at the greyhounds' next start. Prizemoney for the abandoned races is to be split evenly between the eligible greyhounds at the time of abandonment.
