Vintage Candy – Late scratching at 7:02am when Ms Paula Boots reported the greyhound to have diarrhoea (GAR 76). A 10 day stand down period was imposed. Stewards will require a veterinary certificate pursuant to GAR 19(3)(w) before any future nominations will be accepted.

Wild Printers was quick to begin. Inter Robin was very slow to begin (3 lenghts).

Fresh Ability visibly eased and turned its head to the outside several times from approaching the 100m mark to the winning post. Fresh Ability underwent a post-race veterinary examination and was found to have a left gracilis strain. A 10 day stand down period was imposed. Stewards spoke to Mr Gerard O'Keeffe regarding Fresh Ability's racing manners from approaching the 100m mark to the winning post. Acting under the provisions of GAR 125, Fresh Ability was charged with failing to pursue the lure with due commitment (by reason of injury). Mr O'Keeffe pleaded guilty to the charge. Fresh Ability perform a Satisfactory Trial in accordance with GAR 125, and pursuant to GAR 132, before any future nomination will be accepted.

Acting under the provisions of GAR 124, Hot Cross was charged with failing to pursue the lure with due commitment. Mr. Uglietta pleaded guilty to the charge. Hot Cross was suspended for 28 days at Healesville and must perform a Satisfactory Trial in accordance with GAR 127, and pursuant to GAR 132, before any future nomination will be accepted. Stewards spoke to Mr Patrick Furci regarding his conduct behind the starting boxes for this event. A severe reprimand for inappropriate behaviour was issued pursuant to GAR 165(a).
