Acting under the provisions of GAR 125, Shanlyn Rover was charged with failing to pursue the lure with due commitment (by reason of injury). Ms. Cartechini pled guilty to the charge, Shanlyn Rover was found guilty and must perform a Satisfactory Trial in accordance with GAR 125, and pursuant to GAR 132, before any future nomination will be accepted.
