Race 1

FREE ENTRY EVERY MEETING

(250+RANK) 8:37 am 390m Maiden Nichelle Bale was quick to begin.

Race 2

A1 SIGNAGE (250+RANK)

8:52 am 390m Maiden A sample was taken from Shankhill Shandi upon arrival at the course.

Stormin' Frank, Winona Roselee, Vlasta Bale and Blame Billy were slow to begin.

Winona Roselee eased approaching the winning post, underwent a post–race veterinary examination and was found to have no apparent injury. Mr James Forbes declined the option to have the greyhound revetted. Stewards spoke to Mr James Forbes, the trainer of Winona Roselee regarding the greyhound's racing manners approaching the winning post. Acting under the provisions of GAR 124 Winona Roselee was charged with failing to pursue the lure with due commitment. Mr Forbes pleaded guilty to the charge, Winona Roselee was found guilty and suspended for 28 days at Ballarat and must perform a Satisfactory Trial in accordance with GAR 127, and pursuant to GAR 132, before any future nomination will be accepted. Stewards spoke to trainer, Mr James Forbes regarding Winona Roselee pulling up prior to the return gate and failing to enter the catching pen. After hearing evidence from Mr Forbes, viewing all the available race footage and acting on their observations, a warning was issued against the greyhound for failing to enter the catching pen.

Blame Billy severely checked on the first turn and lost ground, underwent a post–race veterinary examination and was re–examined following race five. Blame Billy was found to have a right foreleg monkey muscle injury. A 14 day stand down period was imposed.

Race 3

SJC CONCRETING (250+RANK)

9:07 am 390m Grade 7 Summer Riot – New declared weight of 29.5 kg, last raced at 28.4 kg.

A pre-race sample was taken from Muttley's Crew.

Cause Havoc was slow to begin.

Rojo Silver Fox fell soon after the start, underwent a post–race veterinary examination and was found to have a left foreleg sesamoid injury. A 14 day stand down period was imposed.

Race 4

SHIMA SHINE AT STUD (250+RANK)

9:22 am 390m Grade 7 Madam Magnus escaped from the kennel block during the kennelling process an ran some 150m on the course proper before being restrained. The greyhound was vetted subsequently withdrawn at 8:22 am on the advice of the On–Track Veterinarian (GAR 92) due to cervico-thoracic injury. A three day stand down period was imposed. After hearing submissions from Ms Creed, a warning was issued in accordance with GAR 156(f). In assessing the matter, Stewards took into due consideration that all enclosures leading to the track were open.

Sanp Second was quick to begin. Ten Pineapples and Canya Liston were slow to begin.

Yeah Sweetie severely checked on the first turn and tailed off, underwent a post–race veterinary examination and was found to have a right hindleg calf muscle injury. A five day stand down period was imposed.

Mad Brax faltered on the first turn and tailed off, underwent a post–race veterinary examination and was found to have a right foreleg monkey muscle injury. A21 day stand down period was imposed.

10:12 am 450m Grade 5 A pre-race sample was taken from Pacific Express.

Freddie Fox Trot fell approaching the home turn, underwent a post–race veterinary examination and was found to have a left hindleg sesamoid injury. A five day stand down period was imposed.
