Maggie Pie was severely checked on the first turn, underwent a post-race veterinary examination and was found to have a right back muscle injury. A 60 day stand down period was imposed. Mr Hansen pled guilty to the charge, Luna Town was found guilty and suspended for 28 days at Bendigo and must perform a Satisfactory Trial in accordance with GAR 127, and pursuant to GAR 132, before any future nomination will be accepted.
