Clear Girl lost ground in the home straight, underwent a post–race veterinary examination and was found to have a right hindleg back muscle injury. A 60 day stand down period was imposed.

SPORTSBET GREEN TICKS 3:59 pm 400m Grade 5 T3 Say You Will was quick to begin. Metro Boomin' was slow to begin.

Metro Boomin' was slow to start and was uncompetitive for the remainder of the event, underwent a post–race veterinary examination and was found to have a right hindleg triangle injury. A 28 day stand down period was imposed.
