Race 1

Herb faltered entering the home straight and subsequently tailed off, underwent a post–race veterinary examination and was found to have a right shoulder injury and right thigh injury. A 21 day stand down period was imposed.

A 3 day stand down period was imposed. Stewards spoke to Mr. Lindsay Fulford regarding Brandeen Jerry's racing manners. Acting under the provisions of GAR 125, Brandeen Jerry was charged with failing to pursue the lure with due commitment (by reason of injury). Mr. Fulford pled guilty to the charge and Brandeen Jerry must perform a Satisfactory Trial in accordance with GAR 125, and pursuant to GAR 132, before any future nomination will be accepted.

Ohana Paw Patrol raced ungenerous in the home straight, underwent a post–race veterinary examination and was found to have a left triangle injury. A5 day stand down period was imposed. Stewards spoke to Mr. Raymond Floyd regarding the racing manners of Ohana Paw Patrol in the home straight.
