Race 1

Jodie's Boy (faltered and lost ground soon after the start), underwent a post–race veterinary examination and was found to have right back muscle injury. A 60 day stand down period was imposed.

Aeroplane Tori was quick to begin. All Eagle and Bennachie Miss were slow to begin. Maranello was very slow to begin (3 lengths).

Aeroplane Tori (marred the running of Alfa Bullet in the home straight) underwent a post–race veterinary examination – no apparent injury was reported.

Stewards spoke to Trainer Mr Taylor Thornton regarding Aeroplane Tori's racing manners entering the home straight. Acting under the provisions of GAR 123, Aeroplane Tori was charged with marring. Mr Thornton pleaded guilty to the charge. Aeroplane Tori was found guilty and suspended for 28 days at Shepparton and must perform a Satisfactory Trial/s in accordance with GAR 127, and pursuant to GAR 132, before any future nomination will be accepted.

Maranello underwent a post–race veterinary examination at the trainer's request and was found to have a abrasion to the right eye. No stand down period was imposed.

Short Deuce (lost ground in the home straight), underwent a post–race veterinary examination and was found to have a right back muscle injury. A7 day stand down period was imposed.

Rise Again underwent a post–race veterinary examination at the trainer's request and was found to have a left wrist sprain and a left scapula injury. A 21 day stand down period was imposed.

Stewards spoke to Trainer Mr M.Hetherton regarding Buck Knife's racing manners in the home straight. Acting under the provisions of GAR 123, Buck Knife was charged with marring. Mr Hetherton pleaded guilty to the charge. Buck Knife was found guilty and suspended for three months at all tracks and must perform a Satisfactory Trial in accordance with GAR 127, and pursuant to GAR 132, before any future nomination will be accepted.
