Jake Peralta, Raven Macaw and Detrie Bale were slow to begin.</p> <p>A post-race sample was taken from Mission Apollo – the winner of the event.</p> <p>Mission Apollo underwent a post-race veterinary examination and was found to have a laceration to the left hind leg. A 5 day stand down period was imposed.</p>
<p>Race 3 SPORTSBET HT3 7:35 pm 525m Maiden Heat</p>	<p>A pre-race sample was taken from Master Of Dreams.</p> <p>Master Of Dreams and Royal Silk were quick to begin. Cabao Elderberry and Phoenix March were slow to begin.</p> <p>Phoenix March (lost ground throughout the event and tailed off) underwent a post-race veterinary examination - no injury reported. Stewards spoke to representative Mrs A. Dailly regarding the greyhound's performance in the event. After hearing submissions from Mrs Dailly, considering the beaten margin, time ran and the veterinary's report, Stewards deemed the performance unsatisfactory. Phoenix March must perform a satisfactory trial in accordance with GAR 129, and pursuant to GAR 132, before any future nomination will be accepted.</p> <p>Phoenix October - Stewards spoke to representative Mrs A. Dailly regarding the racing manners of the greyhound soon after the start. After hearing submissions from Mrs. Dailly, viewing the available race footage and having their own observations, the Stewards issued a warning to connections.</p>
