Stewards spoke to representative, Mrs J. Hooke regarding Our Boy Ziggy's racing manners entering the home straight. Acting under the provisions of GAR 125, Our Boy Ziggy was charged with failing to pursue the lure with due commitment (by reason of injury). Mrs Hooke pleaded guilty to the charge. Our Boy Ziggy was found guilty and must perform a Satisfactory Trial in accordance with GAR 125, and pursuant to GAR 132, before any future nomination will be accepted.
