Race 1 AVARD CIVIL GDR (0-4 WINS) 2:52 pm 660m Restricted Win	There were no reportable incidents in this event.
Race 2 AG TYRES & WHEELS GDR (0-4 WINS) 3:17 pm 660m Restricted Win	A pre-race sample was taken from Marionvale Tiger. Marionvale Tiger was slow to begin. Bee Queen raced wide to the first turn. A post-race sample was taken from Bee Queen – the winner of the event. Stewards spoke to trainer, Mr. B. Fothergill regarding their inappropriate conduct behind the boxes towards an official. A warning for inappropriate conduct was issued pursuant to GAR 165(a).
Race 3 GRV VICBRED SERIES HT1 (1-4 WINS) 3:40 pm 500m Restricted Win Heat	Blue Cabang – Late scratching at 3:30pm on the advice of the On-Track Veterinarian (GAR 92) due to diarrhoea. A 5 day stand down period was imposed. Weeona Smiley was quick to begin. Billy Intention was slow to begin. Black Spectre raced wide in the home straight.
Race 4 GRV VICBRED SERIES HT2 (1-4 WINS) 3:57 pm 500m Restricted Win Heat	Angel On Air stumbled at box rise. Back To Scratch and Cool Cabang were slow to begin.
Race 5 GRV VICBRED SERIES HT3 (1-4 WINS) 4:20 pm 500m Restricted Win Heat	Judgement Day was quick to begin. Argyle Maggie raced wide entering the home straight.
Race 6 BENDIGO TO THE MEADOWS HT1 4:37 pm 500m Grade 5 Heat	An out of competition sample was taken from Borneo Brave on 12 October 2023, pursuant to GAR 139. Cailah's Pistol was slow to begin. Quiet Lakes (lost ground approaching the home turn), underwent a post-race veterinary examination and was found to have a right back muscle injury. A 7 day stand down period was imposed. A post-race sample was taken from Militant Storm - the winner of the event.

<p>Race 8</p> <p>BENDIGO TO THE MEADOWS HT3</p> <p>5:17 pm</p> <p>500m</p> <p>Grade 5 Heat</p>	<p>Bruce's Ruslie was slow to begin.</p> <p>War Knee (severely checked approaching the home turn), underwent a post-race veterinary examination – no apparent injury was reported.</p>
<p>Race 9</p> <p>dreamchasersfestival.com.au</p> <p>5:40 pm</p> <p>500m</p> <p>Mixed 4/5</p>	<p>Greysynd Shock and Slingshot Snoop were slow to begin.</p> <p>The Judge incorrectly displayed a dead heat between numbers 2 (1st) and 5 (2nd). This was corrected to 2 (1st) – 5 (2nd) – 6 (3rd) – 1 (4th) before the All Clear was given.</p> <p>The announcement of the All Clear was delayed for the Stewards to review the race footage after a plover was positioned on the track in the back straight and inadvertently made contact with the lure. After viewing the footage and acting on their own observations, the Stewards were comfortably satisfied that no greyhounds were materially affected so as to affect the outcome of the event. The All Clear was posted.</p> <p>Following this event the lure carriage was inspected and deemed safe for racing.</p>

A 10 day stand down period was imposed. Trainer, Mr. Craig Elliot was fined \$100.</p> <p>Vitality Blast was quick to begin.</p> <p>A post-race sample was taken from Verdi - the winner of the event.</p>

A 7 day stand down period was imposed.</p> <p>Stewards spoke to trainer, Mr. D. Geyer regarding the racing manners of Whizbang Gordon at box rise. After hearing submissions from Mr. Geyer, viewing the available race footage and having their own observations, Stewards took no further action.</p>
