Ms Carly Feltham declined the option to have the greyhound re-vetted. Stewards spoke to Ms Feltham regarding the greyhound's racing manners at the 250m and 100m mark. Acting under the provisions of GAR 124, Fritsch was charged with failing to pursue the lure with due commitment. Ms Feltham pleaded guilty to the charge. Fritsch was found guilty and suspended for 28 days at Healesville and must perform a Satisfactory Trial in accordance with GAR 127, and pursuant to GAR 132, before any future nomination will be accepted.

After hearing submissions from Mr Davison, viewing the available race footage and acting on their observations, Stewards deemed the performance of Texicali Sweetie unsatisfactory. Texicali Sweetie must perform a Satisfactory Trial in accordance with GAR 129, and pursuant to GAR 132, before any future nomination will be accepted. Mr Davison stated that he now intends to retire the greyhound.</p>
