Mclvor Roxy (faltered approaching the first turn first and lost ground) underwent a post–race veterinary examination and was found to have a right tarsal fracture. A 60 day stand down period was imposed.

Electra Glide -underwent a post–race veterinary examination and was found to have a left carpal sprain and a left quadriceps injury. A14 day stand down period was imposed.

Stewards spoke to Mr. Gary Mannion regarding Electra Glide's racing manners in the home straight. Acting under the provisions of GAR 124, Electra Glide was charged with failing to pursue the lure with due commitment. Mr. Mannion pleaded not guilty to the charge. Electra Glide was found guilty and suspended for 28 days at all tracks and must perform a Satisfactory Trial in accordance with GAR 127, and pursuant to GAR 132, before any future nomination will be accepted.
