Stewards spoke to Mr. Gary Mannion regarding Electra Glide's racing mannersin the home straight. Acting under the provisions of GAR 124, Electra Glide was charged with failing to pursue the lure with due commitment. Mr. Mannion pleaded not guilty to the charge. Electra Glide was found guilty and suspended for 28 days atall tracks and must perform a Satisfactory Trial in accordance with GAR 127, and pursuant to GAR 132, before any future nomination will be accepted.
