Race 1

FIVE IN A ROW CHIEFS

7:12 pm 400m Maiden No Gizmo was quick to begin. Aston Gozo and Good Boy Boy were slow to begin.

No Gizmo (began well and then lost ground throughout the event) underwent a post–race veterinary examination and was re–examined following race 3, no apparent injury was reported. Stewards spoke to trainer Mr Kenneth Howat regarding No Gizmo's performance in the event, noting its time of 24.477 and finishing over 13 lengths behind the second last greyhound. After hearing submissions from Mr K. Howat, viewing the available race footage and acting on their observations, Stewards deemed the performance of No Gizmo unsatisfactory. No Gizmo must perform a satisfactory trial in accordance with GAR 129, and pursuant to GAR 132, before any future nomination will be accepted.

A post-race sample was taken from Nimble Benny - the winner of the event.

Keep Paying (failed to pursue the lure with due commitment on the home turn and collided with Little Tango) underwent a post–race veterinary examination and was found to have a left hock spike wound. A3 day stand down period was imposed. Stewards spoke to Trainer Ms Angela Langton regarding Keep Paying's racing manners on the home turn. Acting under the provisions of GAR 125, Keep Paying was charged with failing to pursue the lure with due commitment (by reason of injury). Ms A. Langton pleaded guilty to the charge. Keep Paying must perform a satisfactory trial in accordance with GAR 125, and pursuant to GAR 132, before any future nomination will be accepted.
