After hearing submissions from Mr N Bischard, viewing the available race footage and acting on their observations, Stewards deemed the performance of Head Bin unsatisfactory. Head Bin must perform a Satisfactory Trial in accordance with GAR 129, and pursuant to GAR 132, before any future nomination will be accepted.
