Stewards spoke to representative Mr. H. Goss regarding What Hope's racing manners approaching the winning post. Acting under the provisions of GAR 125, What Hope was charged with failing to pursue the lure with due commitment (by reason of injury). Mr. Goss pleaded not guilty to the charge. What Hope was found guilty and must perform a Satisfactory Trial in accordance with GAR 125, and pursuant to GAR 132, before any future nomination will be accepted.
