True Airspeed was slow to begin.</p> <p>Happy Anna (eased approaching the home turn), underwent a post–race veterinary examination and was found to have a left shoulder muscle injury. A 7 day stand down period was imposed.</p> <p>Stewards spoke to trainer Mr P Franklin regarding Happy Anna’s racing manners approaching the home turn. Acting under the provisions of GAR 125, Happy Anna was charged with failing to pursue the lure with due commitment (by reason of injury). Mr P Franklin pleaded guilty to the charge.
