Acting in accordance with GAR 129, and being mindful of the safety of Dundee Coco, other greyhounds in the race, staff, and participants, Stewards were not satisfied with the performance. Dundee Coco was placed on a Satisfactory Trial under GAR 129, and pursuant to GAR 132, with the condition that the greyhound must run past the return gate in order to clear the Satisfactory Trial, before any further nominations are accepted.
