	Stewards took an out of competition sample from the greyhound Whipping It after it was discovered that the greyhound was present on-course during kennelling time.
	Stewards remind all participants that, without having received the permission of Stewards, it is an offence to bring a greyhound on-course which is not engaged in the race meeting, pursuant to GAR 84.
	A sample was taken from Fly Chic upon arrival at the course.
	Dundee Tiara – Late scratching at 6:16pm on the advice of the on–track veterinarian (GAR 92) due to a left long head triceps muscle injury. A21 day stand down period was imposed.
	Celestial Dawn was quick to begin. Kamali was slow to begin.
	Fly Chic (lost ground in the back straight) underwent a post-race veterinary examination and was found to have right long head triceps and left gracilis muscle injuries. A 7 day stand down period was imposed.
	A post-race sample was taken from Misdirected - the winner of the event.

Race 2	A pre-race sample was taken from Groovebird.
GREYHOUNDS ENTERTAINMENT 7:10 pm 515m Mixed 6/7	Groovebird was quick to begin. In accordance with GAR 96, Mr. Jye Formosa was issued with a \$100 fine regarding the use of a mobile phone whilst handling Deputy Fred in the parade area following this event.

Race 6 TOONGABBIE LODGE 8:28 pm 515m Free For All	A pre-race sample was taken from Piscopo Bale. Cosmic Sin and Piscopo Bale were quick to begin. Divine Nature and In The Hub were slow to begin. In The Hub raced wide throughout.
Race 7 grv.org.au/racedata 8:49 pm 515m Mixed 4/5	A sample was taken from Verdi upon arrival at the course. Schillaci, Mepunga Luna and Verdi were slow to begin.
Race 8 LAUNCHING PAD SLOTS ON SALE 9:10 pm 595m Mixed 4/5	A pre-race sample was taken from Fabs Vegetable. Ethanol Volume - Late scratching at 9:11pm on the advice of the On–Track Veterinarian (GAR 92) after the greyhound escaped its handler during the stir-up prior to the event and collided with a closed gate. A 5 day stand down period was imposed and the start of this event was delayed by two minutes as a result of this incident. Following the event, Stewards spoke to Mr. Cooper Bradley, the handler of Ethanol Volume, and issued a warning pursuant to GAR 156(f)(ii). A post-race sample was taken from Stomping - the winner of the event.
Race 9 LAUNCHING PAD - MARCH 28 9:31 pm 515m Grade 5	A sample was taken from Cuthbert Binns upon arrival at the course. Cuthbert Binns was slow to begin. Big Brain (severely galloped on and lost ground turning out of the home straight) underwent a post-race veterinary examination and was found to have minor abrasions to the hind feet. No stand down period was imposed.
Race 10 SPORTSBET SET A DEPOSIT LIMIT 9:49 pm 515m Grade 5	A pre-race sample was taken from Sailplane. Bomb Murt, Pigwidgeon and Phelan Tubman were slow to begin. Pigwidgeon raced wide at box rise.
