6:49 pm 515m Grade 7 The Stewards were advised that the track was deeply harrowed on 11/02/2024.

Pursuant to GAR 75(6), Kennel Attendant Ms. O. Cartechini did not act in any official capacity that may have, in any way, affected the outcome of this event.

Pete's Entity – Late scratching at 10:24am when Trainer Kathleen Boyle reported the greyhound to have abrasions (GAR 76). A 10 day stand down period was imposed. Stewards will require a veterinary certificate pursuant to GAR 19(3)(w) before any future nominations will be accepted.

Dundee Lexi – Late scratching at 5:56pm under GAR 92(4) on the advice of the On–Track Veterinarian after being found to be infested with fleas. Stewards will require a veterinary certificate of clearance stating the condition no longer exists before any future nominations will be accepted.

The closing time of kennelling was altered in accordance with GAR 86 due to the late arrival of Trainer Raymond Brewer who had Dimora Cruz engaged in race 10. The kennels closed at 6.22pm. Mr Brewer was issued a warning.
