River Play was slow to begin.

Annie Coin faltered on the home turn and subsequently pulled up, underwent a post–race veterinary examination and was found to have a left tibia fracture. Annie Coin was humanely euthanised.

A post-race sample was taken from Delta Paws - the winner of the event.

There was no head-on vision available in the front straight for this event.

Following the running of this event, Stewards inspected the track on the home turn and deemed it satisfactory for racing.

Four Aces collided with Adam's Back approaching the first turn and subsequently fell, underwent a postrace veterinary examination and was found to have a left and right back muscle injury. A 7 day stand down period was imposed.

Why Not Emily underwent a post–race veterinary examination and was found to have a right back muscle injury. A 7 day stand down period was imposed.

Borough Premiers contacted the running rail on the first turn and was severely checked approaching the home turn, underwent a post–race veterinary examination and was found to have right back muscle injury. A 10 day stand down period was imposed.
