Race 1

Long Levers (severely checked approaching the home turn), underwent a post–race veterinary examination and was found to have a left sacro-iliac injury. A 10 day stand down period was imposed.

Reiko Venus (checked and lost ground on the first turn), underwent a post–race veterinary examination and was re–examined following race 6. Reiko Venus was found to have a lumbo-sacral injury and a right thigh muscle injury. A 14 day stand down period was imposed.
