Race 1

SPORTSBET GREEN TICKS

(300+RANK) 1:38 pm 350m Grade 7 In Their Honour– Late scratching at 12:55 on the advice of the On– Track Veterinarian (GAR 92) due to diarrhoea. A3 day stand down period was imposed.

Baldo was quick to begin. Valdivian and Hurricane Pat were slow to begin.

A post-race sample was taken from Hurricane Pat - the winner of the event.

Valdivian, underwent a post-race veterinary examination and was found to have a right torn nail. A7 day stand down period was imposed.

Hurricane Tahlia, underwent a post-race veterinary examination - no apparent injury was reported.

Baldo, underwent a post–race veterinary examination and was found to have left spike wound. A 5 day stand down period was imposed. Stewards spoke to Mr Murray Collyer regarding Baldo's racing manners approaching the winning post. Acting under the provisions of GAR 123, Baldo was charged with marring. Mr Collyer pleaded guilty to the charge. Baldo was found guilty and suspended for 28 days at today's track and must perform a Satisfactory Trial in accordance with GAR 127, and pursuant to GAR 132, before any future nomination will be accepted.

(300+ RANK) 1:57 pm 395m Grade 7 Aussie Can Fly, Jellicent Bale and Blue Chaser were slow to begin.

Rio Blazer contacted the running rail and was severely checked in the home turn and tailed off, underwent a post–race veterinary examination and was found to have a right hindleg back muscle injury. A 60 day stand down period was imposed.

The announcement of the All Clear was delayed for the Stewards to review the race footage after ducks was positioned on the track on the home turn and alighted as the greyhounds approached. After viewing the footage and acting on their own observations, the Stewards were comfortably satisfied that no greyhounds were materially affected so as to affect the outcome of the event. The All Clear was posted.
