Arthello Bale must perform a Satisfactory Trial in accordance with GAR 125, and pursuant to GAR 132, before any future nomination will be accepted.

Marino was severely checked on the home turn and subsequently lost ground, underwent a post–race veterinary examination and was found to have a left back muscle injury. A 14 day stand down period was imposed.
