Acting under the provisions of GAR 124, Chief Dribble was charged with failing to pursue the lure with due commitment. Mr Rudd pleaded guilty to the charge. Chief Dribble was found guilty and suspended for three months at all tracks and must perform two Satisfactory Trials in accordance with GAR 127, and pursuant to GAR 132, before any future nomination will be accepted.</p> <p>Trainer Mr R.Hennessy was fined \$50 for failing to ensure the registration card was produced for Go Far Star, pursuant to GAR 88.</p> <p>A post-race sample was taken from Dewana Payout – the winner of the event.</p>
