Due to the interference, Stewards were not comfortably satisfied that Pirate Tails' racing manners constituted a breach of the rules and subsequently took no further action.

Rowcliffe Ruslie was severely checked and contacted the running rail in the home straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed a mild tarsal sprain (hock). A5 day stand down period was imposed.
