Ms. Chilcott pleaded guilty to the charge. Thunder Bay was suspended for 28 days at The Meadows and must perform a Satisfactory Trial in accordance with GAR 127, and pursuant to GAR 132, before any future nomination will be accepted.

Acting under the provisions of GAR 125, Dewana Payout was charged with failing to pursue the lure with due commitment (by reason of injury). Mr. Dewan pleaded guilty to the charge. Dewana Payout must perform a Satisfactory Trial in accordance with GAR 125, and pursuant to GAR 132, before any future nomination will be accepted.

Stewards also spoke to Mr. Dewan regarding the difficulty in boxing Dewana Payout in this event. A warning was issued pursuant to GAR 106(2) and Stewards will continue to monitor the box manners of Dewana Payout at future starts.
